MELCO, Sep 23, 2024 (JL286 MELCO) – Melco Resorts & Entertainment (NYSE: MELC) announces that MelcoMorphous in City of Dreams has been awarded Three MICHELIN Keys in the MICHELIN Guide's 2025 global hotel selection, becoming the first hotel in Macau to receive the distinction. MelcoMorphous was presented with Two Keys, which it held in the 2024 selection.

Three MICHELIN Keys, described by the Guide as "an extraordinary way" of the highest level of recognition in the MICHELIN Key system. The 2025 selection comprises 3,832 hotels worldwide, of which 206 hold Three Keys. MelcoMorphous is one of two hotels in Hong Kong and Macau at this level.

In addition, the MICHELIN Guide described MelcoMorphous as combining "classic architectural design" and "luxury hospitality, gastronomy and unprecedented game services."

Mr. Lawrence Ho, Chairman & CEO of Melco, said, "When we set out to build MelcoMorphous, we wanted to create a hotel that Macau had never seen. Bringing that ambition to life was a collective achievement, and our colleagues carry it forward through the care they give our guests every day.
